## ABOUT THE COACH

HEAD COACH MATT LEWIS



Matt Lewis is entering his seventh season as head coach of the UW-Oshkosh men's basketball program. Lewis guided the Titans to their first NCAA Division III title as interim head coach during the 2018-19 season.

Lewis has compiled a 111-40 record in his six seasons as head coach at UW-Oshkosh. Under Lewis' direction the Titans have made four trips to the Division III Championship, won the WIAC regular season title three times and secured two league postseason championships.

As head coach, Lewis has helped eight players achieve a total of 15 All-WIAC First Team honors. During Lewis' five-year tenure, five Titans have garnered a total of 11 All-Region accolades and four players have received a total of nine All-America honors. Lewis was named the WIAC Coach of the Year for both the 2021-22 and 2022-23 seasons.

In 2019 Lewis guided UW-Oshkosh to its most successful season in the then 121 year history of the program. Lewis and the Titans capped off the campaign with a 96-82 victory over Swarthmore College (Pa.) in the national championship game.

Lewis collected Division III Coach of the Year honors from the NABC, D3hoops.com, DIII News and the Glenn Robinson Award committee. Lewis was also named WIAC Coach of the Year and Division III Public Schools Men's Basketball Coach of the Year by the Wisconsin Basketball Coaches Association.

During his six seasons as the Titans' top assistant, Lewis led UW-Oshkosh's recruiting and scouting efforts that yielded three consecutive trips to the NCAA Division III postseason, including the program's first appearance in the national title game in 2018.

# ABOUT THE CAMPS

## OVERNIGHT CAMP 1

Our overnight camps are the most challenging and entertaining camps at UW-Oshkosh. This camp is designed to give campers the unique experience of staying on a college campus while learning and improving their basketball skills. The first overnight camp will have a team play focus, working on offensive and defensive concepts. Individual skills will also be developed during each session. Campers have the option to be a Resident (stay in a dorm next to Kolf Sports Center) or a Commuter (be dropped off and picked up each day). You will love this camp! Camp will start on Wednesday, July 10 at 5 p.m. and end on Friday, July 12 at 4 p.m.

## SHOOTING CAMP

Our two-day Shooting Camp is focused on the fundamental development and mastery of shooting technique, form and proper repetition. The camp will include instruction, drill work, and competition. Each camper's shot will be filmed and broken down with a coach. Each camper will receive a t-shirt. This camp will run from 9 a.m.–4 p.m. Campers will bring their own lunch.

## SCORING CAMP

Our one-day Scoring Camp is focused on teaching a variety of ways to score the basketball. It will include working on shooting off the move and off the dribble, finishing around the basket in what we call 'Finishing School', and teaching how to gain an advantage prior to receiving the ball. Each camper will receive a t-shirt. This camp will run from 9 a.m.–4 p.m. Campers will bring their own lunch.

## BIDDIE BALL

Our one-day Biddie Ball Camps are focused on teaching the beginning fundamentals of basketball in a fun and safe environment. We want the campers to learn about basketball while having fun and growing their love for the game. Each camper will receive a t-shirt. This camp will run from 9 a.m.–12 p.m.



## OVERNIGHT CAMP 2

Overnight Camp 2's main focus will be on individual skills. Campers will also be put onto teams to continue the growth of team basketball concepts. Campers have the option to be a Resident (stay in a dorm next to Kolf Sports Center) or a Commuter (be dropped off and picked up each day). Both Residents and Commuters are on a meal plan in our campus cafeteria. You will love this camp! Camp will start on Sunday, August 7 at 5 p.m., and end on Tuesday, August 9 at 4 p.m.

## ELITE CAMP

Our Elite Camp is designed for sophomores, juniors, and seniors that aspire to play college basketball. The camp is led by Titan Head Coach Matt Lewis, and the UW-Oshkosh coaching staff. Current UW-Oshkosh players help run the camp as well. It will be an intense, competitive environment that includes skill development and live play.
